



Dear Parents,

You may or may not be aware that in the past we have withdrawn pupils from the school production.

Our contract clearly states that every pupil participating in Pearl Anthology MUST be present at ALL rehearsals at the theatre. There are many reasons for this rule, including choreography, spacing, placing and partnering within each dance number, however above all......

A theatre is not a playground, far from it. During the rehearsals the children are given time on the stage, in the wings etc with a *working light*. This enables them to see the stage, edges, wings, cables, lights, tabs, heavy weights (the list goes on), all of which are potentially dangerous. Pupils must also be present at any safety talks given by the theatre to comply with regulations. It is important that pupils are familiar and confident in the environment so they enjoy their experience on stage.

Therefore please remember this attendance rule applies to all .

## EMERGENCY CONTACT NUMBERS

We feel that banning mobiles would be impossible and many students use their mobiles as a vital form of communication with their parents. Therefore, we implore students to think before they click and post.

May we ask chaperones to be vigilant, any concerns please come directly to Nicola or Hazel.

Finally we must make it clear that we are not responsible for any loss or damage to any phones and valuables. Indeed, we are not responsible any photographs taken and uploaded by students.


#### HAIR - NO doughnuts!

**WHY?** Because they impede the wearing of hats and headdresses. BUNS should be at the back (NOT the top) of the head,

still leaving the neck line free.

When pupils arrive at the theatre they will be expected to have their hair tied into a bun (with pins & nets not just scrunchies). So in practise for the perfect bun, it will be compulsory for all students to wear their hair in a bun for all classes ~ including tap and modern. This will be stringently enforced.







From Brentwood go to Ongar on the A128 (Ongar Rd) from Ongar take the A414 to Harlow (continue straight until you meet the third roundabout ~ junction with M11)

From M11 junction into Harlow A414

Down hill to first roundabout ~ go straight

At second roundabout (with old clock tower) ~ Take left exit into Second Avenue (A1025)

Continue straight until third roundabout (see arrow at roundabout)

Take left exit into Third Avenue (A1169) pass Water Gardens & TK Max on right

At first roundabout turn right into Haydens Road

Playhouse and multi-storey car park is on your right.

NB to enter car park and theatre, go to next roundabout and come back on yourself when car park will be on your left.
