## MOVING THROUGH THE GRADES

~ WITH OUT TAKING EXAMS

We endeavour to accommodate all students with the option to take exams or not.

If a pupil decides to take an exam they are requested to attend extra classes because of the standards required by the examining boards. Extra classes run for the entirety of the term (unless specified).

In many cases the commitment to these classes is sometimes not possible (for various understandable reasons including personal available time, other commitments or indeed finances). However if a pupil wishes to continue moving through the grades without taking an exam it is vital that attendance to their regular class is maintained. Poor attendance means they will not have covered the work and achieved a reasonable level to be able to cope with the demands of the next grade.

The grades are structured as such that the work within one grade develops into the next. Therefore it is essential that students have a good grounding whether or not participating in the exam. Otherwise they will struggle and feel overwhelmed when attempting the more demanding higher grade.

## "IT'S MY TURN"

This is a comment often heard. We need to understand that every child is an individual and therefore progress at their own rate depending on natural factors such as growth spurts and illness.

Also if a pupils attendance is poor within a non exam term they cannot expect to be ready or considered for the next exam session.

As much as we try to keep friends together, examinations should only be entered as and when a student is confident and ready so the exam is a positive experience.

## CHRISTMAS CONCERT at the BRENTWOOD CENTRE






With the number of students on the premises we are always considering their health and safety.
